I'm happy to share my 10 Powerful Choices to help you live each day with less stress and more joy. I created this list for a speech I delivered last summer. It's based on the premise that you can more intentionally decide who and how you want to be in the moments of your life. Exercising more of your personal power can lead to more freedom, which in turn, can lead to more joy and ease.

I invite you to choose to ...

Stop taking things personally. Nothing anyone says or does is about you – it is always about them, but making it about you. This powerful choice alone will change your life.

Stop believing all your thoughts. How would your life change if you paid more attention to your supportive, creative, uplifting thoughts and less to your judgmental, critical, fear-based thoughts?

Stop letting fear drive. Fear is a physiological mechanism originally designed to keep our ancestors safe in an appropriate time and environment. But now it often gets in the way of our growth. When you know you're safe, try putting fear in the back seat.

Stop living out your story. Your story is the data you've collected about yourself and everything that has happened to you during your life. But it can limit you and the way you see life and others. Free yourself from your story.

Stop judging yourself and others. This relates to #1 – everything and everyone you judge is really about you. Next time you catch yourself judging, get curious: why is this causing a reaction in me? Have more compassion, for yourself and others. Compassion is often the antidote to judgment. Next time you're in judgement, which doesn't feel good, notice how it feels to allow some compassion in.

Smile more, for no reason. Smiling is a powerful mind/body tool we can use deliberately, not just as a conditioned response. The act of smiling triggers a happy chemical reaction in the brain. Try waking up and smiling as the first thing you do.

Focus inward for 5 minutes a day. Allowing yourself some quiet, self-connection time each day will help you recalibrate to who you really are and what matters most to you.

Make time for your passions and purpose. What makes you feel most alive? Choose to do more of that.

Become your own best friend. How would it feel to speak to yourself, encourage yourself, love yourself like your best friend? This powerful choice is another game (life) changer.

Did one or two of these powerful choices speak to you? That's your inner wisdom guiding you - I suggest you start there.
