



Fire Safety at Home: Everyday Hazards You Might Overlook



It's easy to think of fire safety as something handled by alarms and emergency responders, but real prevention starts with the small choices we make every day. The forgotten phone charger, the unattended stovetop, and the e-bike battery charging in the wrong place are all seemingly harmless habits that can quickly turn into fire risks.

Here are a few unexpected risks to watch for:

Forgotten Kitchen Dangers

Most people know leaving the stove unattended is a fire hazard, but everyday habits can also increase risk. Cooking with oil? A sudden grease flare-up can ignite instantly. Toasters and microwaves? Crumbs or food debris can overheat and catch fire. Clean appliances regularly and keep a lid nearby for smothering flames.

Overloaded Outlets & Hidden Electrical Risks

Power strips can seem harmless, but plugging multiple high-wattage devices into one outlet can cause overheating. Charging your phone overnight under a pillow? A covered charging cable traps heat, increasing fire risk. Ensure cords are in open spaces and replace frayed wires immediately.

Electric Bike and Scooter Battery Storage

Electric bikes and scooters are becoming more common, but improper battery storage can be a serious fire hazard. Never charge or store electric bikes and scooters on a balcony—weather exposure can damage batteries. Instead, keep them indoors in a cool, dry place and use only manufacturer-approved chargers. Please contact your management team to learn more about your community policies regarding electric bikes and scooters.

Dryer Vents

Dryer vents may not seem like a fire hazard, but lint buildup is a leading cause of home fires. Make sure to clean the lint trap before or after every load, and avoid overloading the dryer, which can lead to overheating.

CAPREIT conducts regular fire safety system checks to ensure all residents are protected. Help these inspections go smoothly by:

- Keeping fire safety areas clear and avoid placing furniture or decorations in front of alarms, sprinklers, or emergency exits.
- Never tampering with smoke detectors or safety equipment. These devices must remain functional to detect fires and keep everyone safe.
- Following inspection notices. When a fire safety check is scheduled, ensure inspectors have easy access to alarms and equipment.

Protection for your belongings

Think about all the things you own, mainly how many boxes it would take to move all your belongings. Throughout the years, that can quickly accumulate. This goes beyond furniture, including electronics, clothing, jewellery, sporting equipment, and other valuables.

Renters need to have the right insurance to cover the expense of replacing their belongings if something happens.

Liability coverage

Another critical aspect of tenant insurance is liability coverage. If an accident occurs such as leaving something in the oven and you cause damage to not only your unit but also the rest of the apartment building, you would be responsible for that damage. Liability coverage protects you.

Living expenses

Having something happen to your home can be extremely stressful. Tenant insurance can take away some of that stress during a claim when you are unable to stay in your residence.

Additional Living Expense coverage is there to help cover the cost of alternative living arrangements over and above your normal costs during this time. This includes assistance with the additional cost of meals over and above your normal cost until you're back home or have access to cooking facilities in your temporary accommodation.
